#### **ANZ-Indeed Australian Job Ads: stabilisation**

ANZ-Indeed Australian Job Ads rose 0.3% m/m in October, following an upwardly revised 2.3% m/m rise in September. In trend terms, the series was up 0.5% m/m.

ANZ-Indeed Australian Job Ads has fallen 27.0% from its peak in June 2022 but is still 16.1% above pre-pandemic levels.

ANZ Economist, Madeline Dunk: ANZ-Indeed Australian Job Ads recorded its second consecutive rise, with the series up 2.6% over the last two months. This suggests the downward trend in Job Ads may be stabilising.

The lift follows a string of stronger than expected Labour Force Survey results. Employment growth has averaged 45k over the past six months, the participation rate is at a record high, and the unemployment rate remains relatively low at 4.1%. Some of this strength is linked to the ongoing expansion of the care economy, with the 'carers and aides' occupation group showing the largest increase in employment over the last year. Given the ageing population and growth in the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), it's likely we will see demand for workers in this sector continue to rise solidly.

Indeed Senior Economist, Callam Pickering: In October, growth in Job Ads was concentrated in South Australia and New South Wales, which more than offset a drop in Victoria and Tasmania. The 15.8% annual decline in Job Ads has mainly been driven by New South Wales and Victoria, with more modest declines observed elsewhere.

Growth in Job Ads in October were Christmas-themed, with both retail and food service opportunities rising considerably. Customer service Job Ads also rose. Over the past three months, Job Ads have increased in half of all sectors, a notable improvement on the widespread declines from earlier this year. This is another sign that Job Ads may be stabilising.

### **Appendix**

#### Data sources

The internet series counts the average number of job ads carried by each of the sites contributing to the series on the same day of each week in the month indicated. The day (which is not necessarily the same for each site) is selected by the site operator as broadly representative of its activity levels. The data are based on information provided by the operators of the following sites:

- Indeed (au.indeed.com); 2018-ongoing
- Workforce Australia, Department of Employment and Workplace Relations (workforceaustralia.gov.au) and previous iterations; 1999-ongoing
- SEEK (seek.com.au); 1999–2022
- Newspaper job ads; 1975–2018

Historical data going back to 1975 is published here.

#### Seasonal adjustment and trend

X-11 ARIMA is used for seasonal adjustment and trend estimates. New and revised original monthly data can result in revisions to the seasonal factors for historical estimates.
